

Unimog beyond borders

UCG Annual Meeting: September 11th to 13th in Wilbertoord (Netherlands)

Experience Dutch hospitality: that's what the weekend of September 11 to 13 is all about at the 2026 annual meeting of the Unimog-Club Gaggenau. This is made possible by the UCG's partnership with De Peeltuffers, a club for historic tractors. Together, we are organizing the "Wilbertoord Pakt Uit 2026" event. Whether

you are a member or not (yet), all MB-trac and Unimog fans are cordially invited to Wilbertoord. The town is located in the southeast of the Netherlands in the province of Noordbrabant, less than 40 kilometers from the German border.





Program

A unique Unimog and MB-trac experience awaits. You can look forward to a Unimog museum with many vehicles on display. There will be action on the demonstration area, and spare parts will be available at the stands of numerous dealers. But Wilbertoord Pakt Uit offers much more – and above all, a program for every age group. In addition to MB-trac and Unimog, historic vehicles from other brands will also be on display. There will be excitement at competitions such as Hobby Pulling & Cross, where tractors have to pull a heavy brake car. Regional products will be offered at a trade market.

Whether rock, pop, or brass band music: bands will play live on various stages. Three festive evenings are also planned. On Friday, dirndl and lederhosen are expressly desired, as German classics from the 80s and 90s will be played. On Saturday, cover bands from the surrounding villages will provide live music to create a great atmosphere. On Sunday, there will be party music once again to round off the event. Children can let off steam on bouncy castles and try out quad bikes. On Sunday

morning, a church service will be held in the festival tent. A hot air balloon festival is planned for the finale on Sunday evening.

Catering & accommodation

Food and drinks will be provided at the festival site: a team of volunteers will ensure a varied selection of food. In addition, the UCG will also offer breakfast, lunch, and dinner separately. All details can be found on the registration form. Only on Thursday evening and Monday morning will you have to resort to the cafés and restaurants in the surrounding villages.

If you want to arrive earlier or extend your stay, there are numerous campsites in the area. In Wilbertoord itself, these include the Boerderijcamping run by the Gieben farming family (www.boerderijcampinggieben.nl), Camping Boszicht (www.campingboszicht.nl), and Minicamping 't Amans (www.amans.nl).

Excursions & tour

A 40-kilometer tour of the region is being organized for Saturday. There are three departures throughout the day; registration takes place

on site. There will be a rest stop along the route with food (hamburgers) and drinks. There are also many places to visit in the vicinity of Wilbertoord. It is only 19 kilometers to the Overloon War Museum (www.oorlogsmuseum.nl) and 14 kilometers to the historic fortified town of Grave (www.visitlandvancuijk.com). The Sporen van de Oorlog and De Kuilen areas are ideal for hiking. Destinations for children include the De Bergen (www.avonturenparkdebergen.nl) and Billy-Bird Hemelrijk (www.billybird.nl) amusement parks, as well as the zoos in Overloon (www.zooparc.nl) and Uden (www.dierenparkziezoo.nl). Pure relaxation is offered by a wellness boat with 41 sauna and spa areas (www.wellnesshotelbrabant.nl).

The fairground is open from Thursday, September 10th, 5:00 p.m. to Monday, September 14th,

10:00 a.m. The grounds close at 10:00 p.m. in the evening. There are plenty of showers and toilets on site, as well as a disposal station for chemical toilets. Groups can set up together on the grounds, but should register in advance by email (john.vandijk@unimog-club-gaggenau.de). In the neighboring town of Wanroij, there is a gas station (De Haan, Millseweg 25) and a supermarket (Albert Heijn, Lepelstraat 1).

The Netherlands plans to introduce a truck toll on July 1. Motorhomes of the type "motorhome (SA)" that are registered outside the Netherlands are generally not subject to the toll. Vehicles that are both older than 40 years and used exclusively for private purposes are also exempt from the toll. If both conditions are met, such a vehicle only needs to be registered online in advance for an exemption.

All other vehicles in classes N2 and N3 (trucks with a technically permissible total weight of more than 3.5 tons) are subject to the toll. Therefore, a toll device from a Dutch or European provider must be installed in the vehicle

and switched on, regardless of whether toll roads are actually used. However, it is possible to cross the German-Dutch border from Goch without using toll roads by taking the N291 => N271 => N264 route. Further information: www.vrachtwagenheffing.nl ■
